"...in order to be eligible to serve as a voting delegate, one must be a bona fide farmer who is an active member of good standing in the Federation and his principal occupation must be the active engagement in the production of agricultural, horticultural, dairy, livestock, poultry, bee, commercial fishing and trapping, or other farm and forestry products."

"A <u>bona fide farmer</u> is defined as an individual who is actively engaged in the production of agricultural, horticultural, dairy, livestock, poultry, bee, commercial fishing and trapping, or other farm and forestry products, and who receives a substantial portion of his income from such products."

"<u>Good standing</u>" means that the active member has paid his membership dues for the year in which he seeks certification as a voting delegate.

"Principal occupation" means a majority of one's time.

"<u>Active engagement</u>" means the regular and continuing participation in management decisions respecting the farming operation.

A voting delegate must be a member of the parish Farm Bureau he or she represents.
