Rules for the 2018 LFBF Annual Convention Competition

Background

The Outstanding Young Farm Woman Award is a program designed and promoted by the Louisiana Farm Bureau Federation (LFBF) Young Farmers & Ranchers (YF&R) Committee to recognize women for outstanding achievement. The role of women in agriculture has changed a great deal in the past decade. As their roles change, the State Young Farmers and Ranchers Committee felt a program was needed to recognize their efforts and promote leadership development. It is our hope that the Outstanding Young Farm Woman Award will assist in reaching this goal. It is recommended that parish Farm Bureaus provide an expenses-paid trip to the LFBF State Convention held in 2018 in New Orleans, LA June 21- June 24.

Information about the Outstanding Young Farm Woman applicant is requested on the entry form. ALL INFORMATION IS HANDLED IN STRICT CONFIDENCE AND IS DESTROYED AFTER JUDGING IS COMPLETED.

<u>Eligibility</u>

- Applicant(s) shall be a Farm Bureau member(s) between the ages of 18 and 35 in good standing with her parish Farm Bureau. The individual or spouse/spousal-equivalent shall have reached her 18th birthday at the time she qualifies for the state competition and shall not have reached his/her 36th birthday by Jan. 31, 2019.
- Applicants are able to apply for both the Outstanding Young Farm Woman Award and either the Achievement Award, or the Discussion Meet.
- Past state Outstanding Young Farm Women winners are not eligible to compete.
- Current employees of parish, state and/or American Farm Bureau employees are not eligible to compete.
- Contestants should derive a majority of their income from an owned agricultural operation.
- Each parish may submit one entry to be considered for state recognition and must use the LFBF entry form and application.

Entry Form & Application Guidelines

- Applicants for the State Award must use the official entry form posted online at <u>www.lafarmbureau.org</u>. Please keep your answers within the space allowed.
- Do not use applicant's name, the name of her parish, or any names that may bring about the recognition or identification of the applicant's parish beyond the entry form (pages 1-4).

Note: Disregarding any of the guidelines listed above will result in disqualification.

<u>Judging</u>

- The entry form and application of each state entry will be coded upon receipt by LFBF. The applicant's name and parish will not be revealed to the judges until judging is completed.
- Judging is based on the application sent to LFBF by the parish Farm Bureau and an interview prior to the LFBF State Convention.
- A panel of three qualified judges will select the state winner. The Top 3 competitors will be interviewed by the same three judges who reviewed the written applications.
- Finalists interviews will be conducted during the week of May 21-25.
- Interviews will be up to 20 minutes in length and are intended to clear up any "gray areas" which may arise from the written application. The Top 3 competitors should understand that their interview is for verification/clarification purposes and therefore may affect final rankings.
- During the interview process, only the named applicant(s) on the entry form is permitted into the interview.
- The basis of their award is the individual's contributions to agriculture:

TOTAL POINTS	100 points
Involvement in community and service programs	<u>10 points</u>
Involvement in ag-related organizations	25 points
Knowledge of agriculture	25 points
Regular/ Daily involvement in personal farming operation	40 points

Deadline

Applications must be **received** in the state office no later than <u>MARCH 1, 2018</u>. The digital version of this application can be found online at <u>www.lafarmbureau.org</u>. Each parish should take advantage of the opportunity for much valuable publicity and promotion in recognizing its parish winners on a local level.
